DrawingSearcher Software License Agreement

PLEASE READ THIS LICENSE CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THIS SOFTWARE. BY CLICKING THE "YES" BUTTON OR BY USING THIS SOFTWARE, YOU AGREE TO BECOME BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS LICENSE. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS OF THIS LICENSE, CLICK THE "NO" BUTTON, DO NOT USE THIS SOFTWARE, AND PROMPTLY RETURN IT TO THE PLACE WHERE YOU OBTAINED IT FOR A FULL REFUND.

1. **License**. This License allows you to:

- (a) Use one copy of DrawingSearcher on a single computer ("DrawingSearcher Server") which may be accessed by multiple client computers ("Client") through a web browser interface. Each DrawingSearcher license is a single user "Floating network license" allowing for one (1) client user connection to the DrawingSearcher Server. DrawingSearcher contains a license management application that authorizes and monitors the number of licenses which are concurrently connected to the DrawingSearcher Server at the same time. If the number of licensed users is exceeded, a warning message is issued indicating a license is not available. If the DrawingSearcher application is used on a network/intranet or the Internet in conjunction with a proxy server or other software/hardware device that "masks" the IP address to the DrawingSearcher Server, the user/administrator remains responsible for administrating DrawingSearcher in such a way that the number of concurrent users does not exceed the number of licenses owned. To "use" the Software means that the Software is either loaded in the temporary memory (i.e., RAM) of a computer and/or installed on the permanent memory of a computer (i.e., hard disk, etc.).
- (b) Make one (1) copy of DrawingSearcher in machine readable form solely for backup purposes.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other terms in this License, if the Software is licensed as an upgrade or update, then you may only use the Software to replace previously valid licensed versions of the same software. - 4. **Export Law Assurances**.
